On Picket-Sunday March 20<sup>th</sup> 1864

My dear Sister

Again I take my pen in hand to write you a few lines for it is a pleasure to write to you and I love to get a letter from you the best of any of my correspondents except one and you may guess who that is. - I received a letter from you yesterday and was glad to hear that you were all well at home and in return I will say that I am well as usual and am enjoying life well. I had a letter from Nathan today and he is well as usual. - As you see by the date of my letter I am on picket and have been since last Friday morning and shall not get back to camp
