I have received no letter from you in a long long time but if you are to begin to write I suppose I shall have to wait untill you get time. I shall always be glad to get a letter from you whenever you feel like writing to me. I know that I cannot write a very interesting letter to you still I shall continue to afflict you with a letter now and then if you have no objection I do not remember of receiving more than two letters from you in as many months but I will not complain.

Our Regt. or I should say our Battalion of the 6th W. together with the old W. Brigade are now Camped about Strasburg Pa.
