breaking down isolation through  
community and network building, the  
need for more comprehensive AIDS  
education and services, a statewide  
lesbian/gay rights legislative agenda,  
organizing groups in currently  
unorganized areas of the state, and the  
need for networking within the  
professions and the workplace.

The group stated its strong  
commitment to working in coalition  
with lesbians and a willingness to work  
to build an atmosphere of trust and  
respect through the development of a  
common agenda and non-sexist  
operation. High hopes were expressed  
for the outcome of the March 2nd joint  
meeting of lesbians and gay men.
