the complexity of medical statistics makes it difficult for the gay community to receive the specific and understandable information it needs. It was to address this need that VT C.A.R.E.S. (Committee on A.I.D.S. Resources, Education and Services) was formed.

vithin the gay community. VT C.A.R.E.S. is actively finalizing a risk reduction/safe sex program for high risk groups in VT. VT C.A.R.E.S., however, needs groups from within the community to sponsor meetings where this information can be shared. VT C.A.R.E.S. is asking that the established gay organizations and support groups consider devoting a meeting to the presentation of this risk reduction/safe sex program.
