If you have to be separated from your lover make sure that you both set up time to talk while away, as it will be hard on him/her as it is on you. If you are going to be away from your support system for a while, he sure to know where they are if you need to talk to an understanding friend if things get tough. If you have recently come out to family members and this will be the first holiday since

that happened don't be too paranoid about their reactions. Take care of your self: if you get angry at yourself, if you overeat or indulge in other things, try to avoid that. Continue your exercise program at home, take a walk, get away. If you choose not to deal with the holidays then do so without guilt. Taking care of yourself has to be a priority. Visit your family at some other time of the year - they may not understand, but that is their problem, not yours. Don't let the holiday time

interfere with the good feelings we have about who we are - holiday times can be great if we realistic expectations about them.
