from page 11 Coordinator Hired people will visit their representatives to lobby for the Lesbian and Gay Civil Rights Bill while a massive act of non-violent civil disobedience directed at the Supreme Court will take place in protest of last summer's sodomy ruling.

The demands of the march are:

(1) Legal recognition of lesbian/gay relationships;

(2) The repeal of all laws that make sodomy between consenting adults a crime;

(3) A Presidential Order be issued banning anti-gay discrimination by the Federal Government;

(4) Passage of the Congressional Lesbian/Gay Civil Rights Bill;

(5) An end to discrimination against People With AIDS or those perceived to have AIDS;

(6) A massive increase in funding for AIDS education, treatment, research, and patient care; that these monies come from the defense budget;

(7) The right to reproductive freedom and an end to sexism; the right to practice our sexuality freely;

(8) An end to racism in the U.S. and apartheid in South Africa.
