3. Let the members of the Senate Judiciary Committee know you support the bill. The members are:



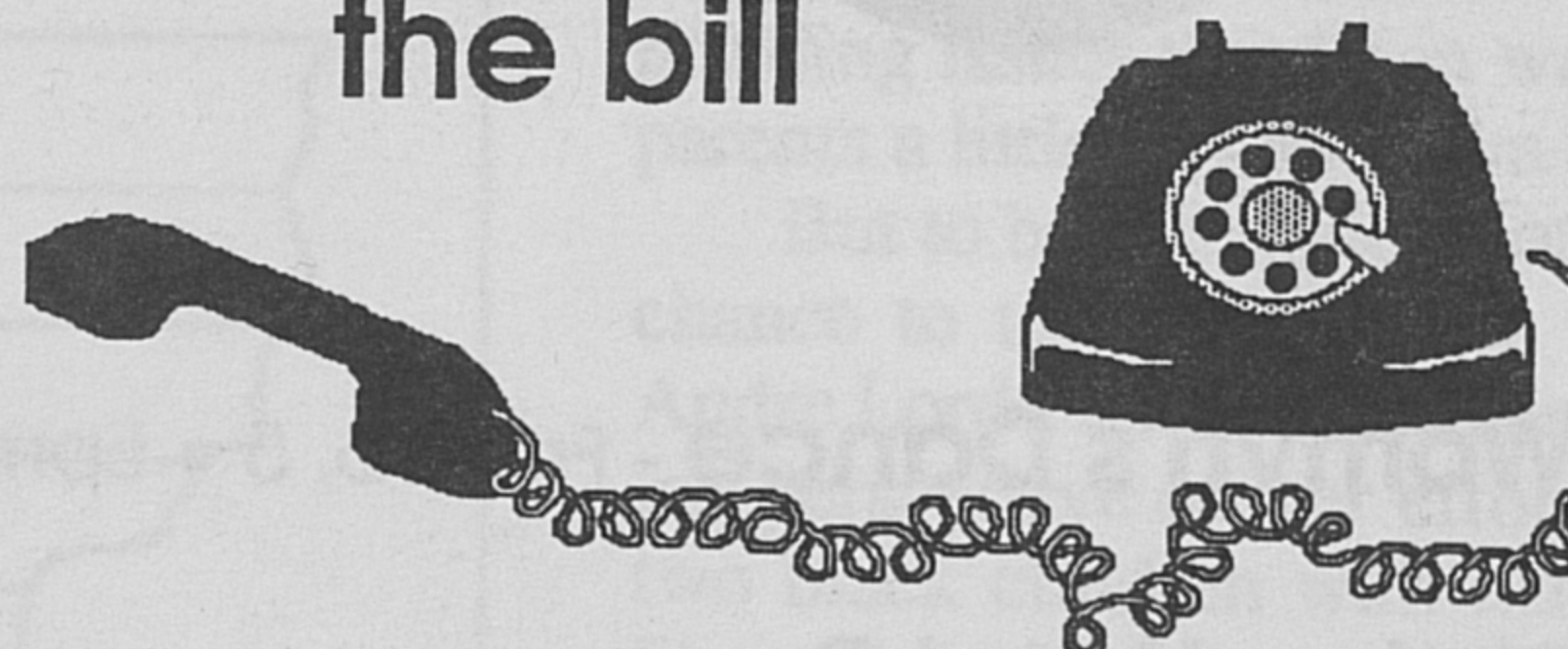
The dance was sponsored by Rutland Area Gay and Lesbian Task Force. Keep up the good work!
