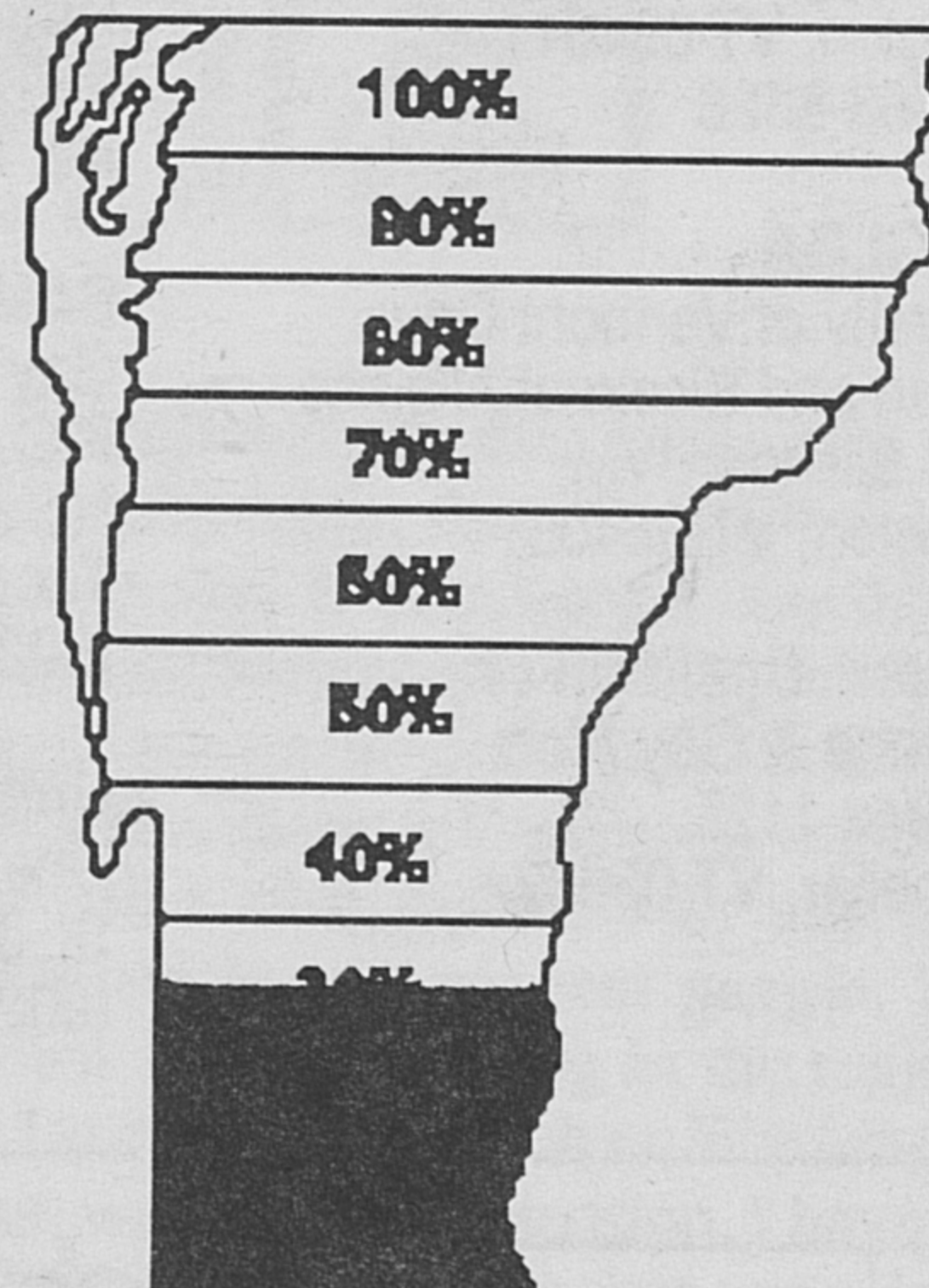
Benefit Dance in Montpelier
