

Jess Hawk Oakenstar Performs

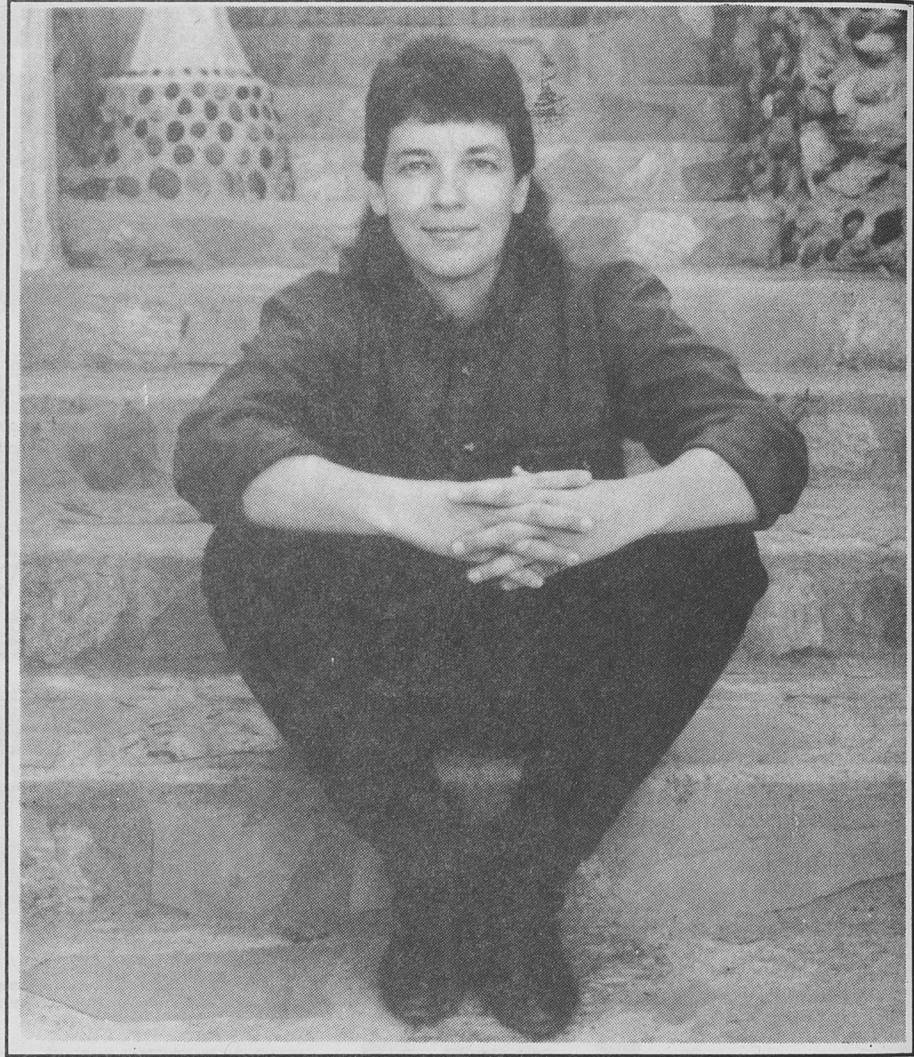

Jess Hawk Oakenstar will be returning to the Barre Montpelier area on Friday, September 17th to perform at the Barre Universalist Church at 7:30 pm. There will be a benefit buffet dinner before the concert at 6:00 pm.

Jess is a lesbian solo performer/songwriter whose deep rich voice and sophisticated guitar work fuse contemporary folk, country and rock into her own style. She writes and presents songs with an attitude although she is definitely a performer without one. Her songs cover such subjects as women's heroism, friendship, unity and Desert Storm.

Oakenstar was born and raised in Zimbabwe, and later lived in New Zealand, during which time she was involved in women's music as a guitarist, singer, and songwriter. She has written and performed music for feminist theater and revues, and has toured New Zealand with two of the revues.
