Gore Vidal sums it up, "the muddle the Judeo-Christian nightmare has made of our sexual attitudes is something not to be believed."

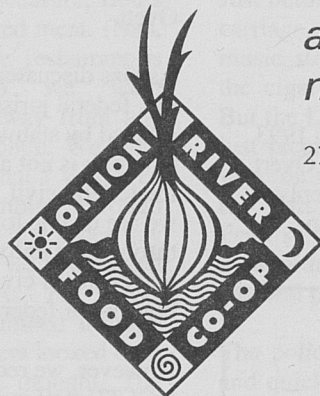

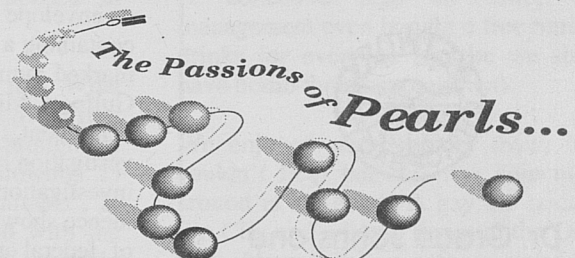
