A look at our lives as expressed through the unique contributions we've made to art, music, literature and history with a special focus on the l/g/b/t communities of Vermont.

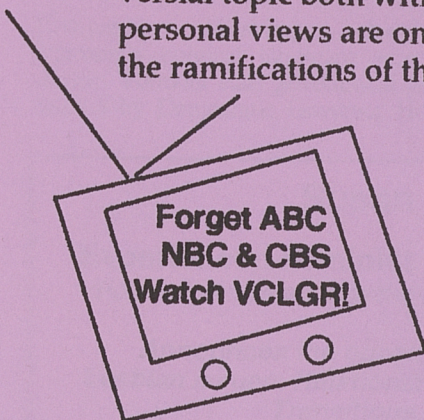
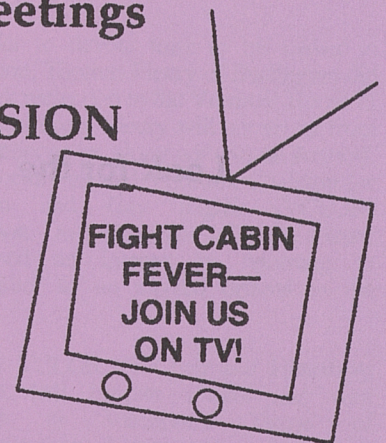
April: Family Issues
