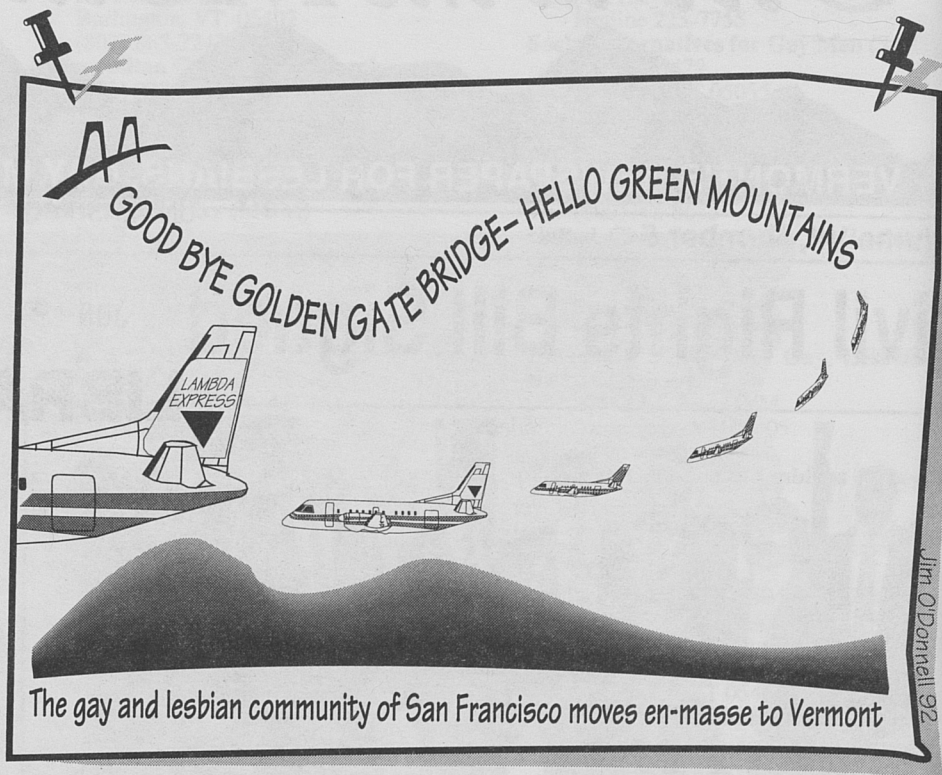

Free instruction in the use of studio cameras, camcorders, editing equipment and production is provided. Program production is also done at no charge.

One only need contact their local Cable TV provider to get information. Public Access is a wonderful tool to be used and welcomes the diversity of many voices to its programming agenda.

After learning how, one may simply arrange to tape a public meeting, concert or theatrical production to be aired. Others may wish to produce their own consciousness raising spots, panel dis-
