
Robert W. Mundstock, 45, died October 11, 1992 at home following complications from AIDS.


Bob was the artist-owner of Monarch Studios. A former candlemaker and high school art teacher, he was known locally as an oil painter of Vermont landscapes and a stained glass designer. Bob was a member of the Board of Directors of the Artisans' Hand Craft Cooperative in Montpelier until his death. He was also a founder of Vermont C.A.R.E.S., the first AIDS service organization in Vermont; a member of the Board of Directors of the Community Health Center in Burlington, serving as President from 1980-1982; a founder of the Mansfield Bucks; a founder and logo designer of the statewide newsletter Out in the Mountains; and for nine years led bicycle tours in England, California, and New England as a senior leader for the Vermont Bicycling Touring Company in Bristol. He was an avid birdwatcher and active member of the Audubon Society, enjoyed sailing, volleyball and travel.

The Vermont Department of Health awarded Bob the 1992 AIDS Awareness Award in recognition of his pioneering work in AIDS education with high school and college students and their parents.

Bob was born in Chicago, Illinois on April 13, 1947, and attended the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, receiving his Bachelor of Science Degree in Education in 1970. His quick wit and love of life will be missed by his mother, Margaret (Peg) Mundstock of Montpelier; three sisters, Peg Carlson of Salem, WI, Kathy Redmond of Antioch, IL, and Tina Starfire of Worland, NY; two nieces; a nephew; and numerous other relatives and friends.
