

Pioneering Course

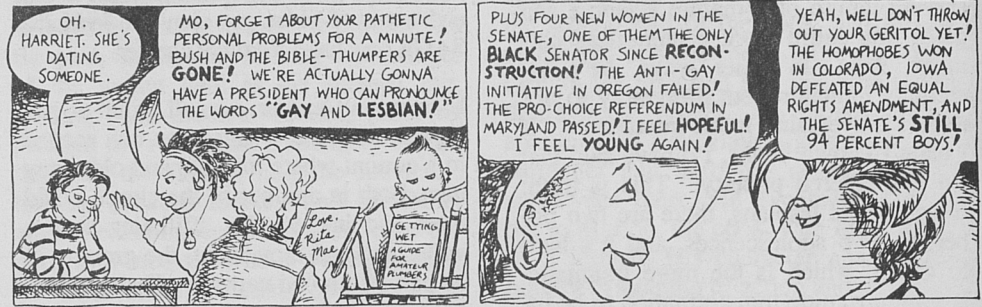
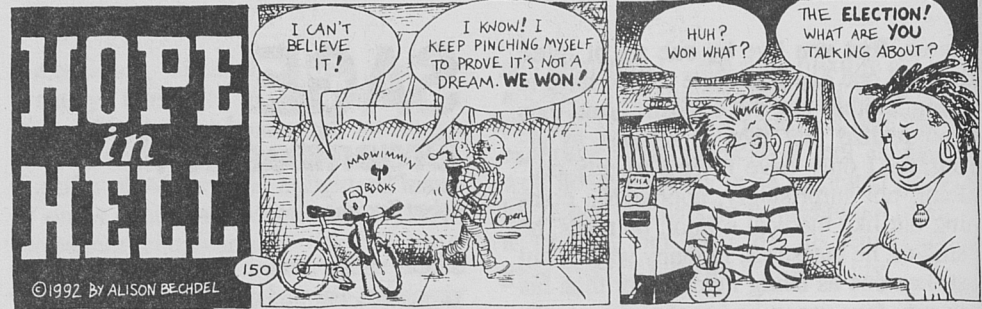
