Actions Speak Louder Than Words

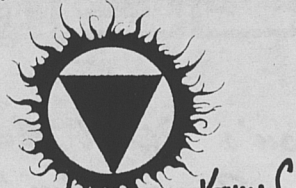
R. Kwietniowski

A Good Dyke Gone Mad

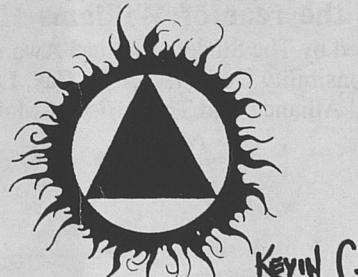
H. Pearl
