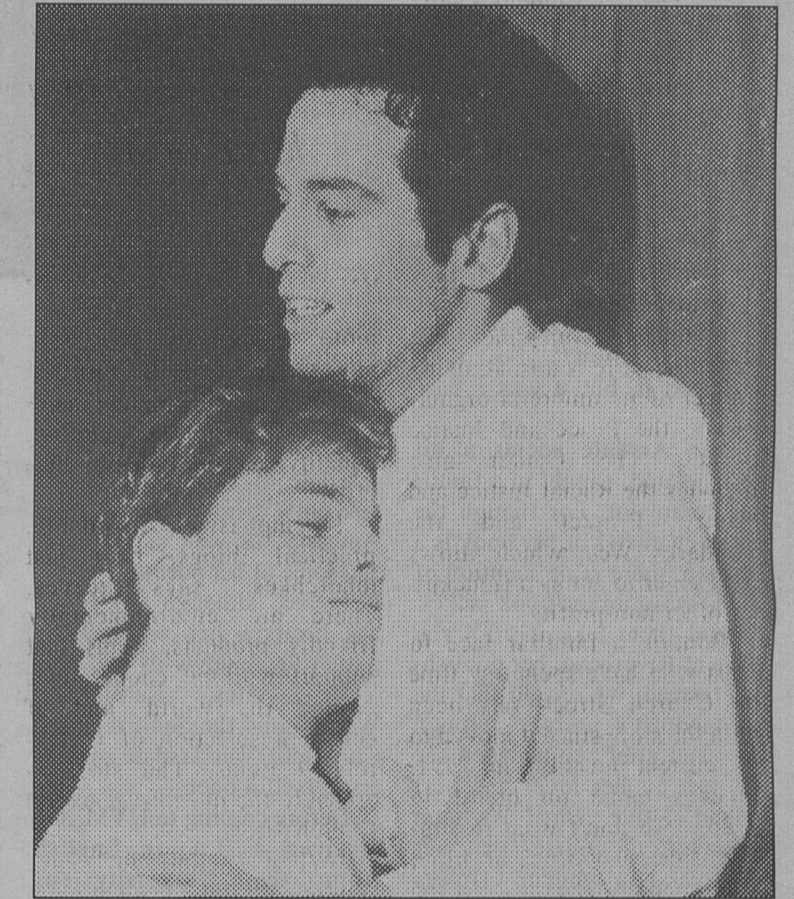
CHIN HO! ALBUM RELEASE PARTY

Everything You Know is Wrong,"the is an eleven-song album produced by Chin Ho! at Eclipse Recording in Hinesburg and mixed by Glen Robinson at the Studio Victor in Montreal, Quebec. Featuring the singles "I Wish I Was a Girl" and "So David Kamm Said," the album also features live Chin Ho! favorites "Eight Track," "Closet Case," "Weird" and a tribute to friends of the band who lost the AIDS battle called "Song for a Dead Friend."

In the arts and culture segment you'll see stories on an all-male version of Romeo and Juliet, an all-female Shakespeare company, and the opera Patience and Sarah, about two women who fell in love and shared their lives in the 1800s.
