Ethiopia seeing kids with no hands because the parents had cut them off so they could beg."

Even those of us who were more integrated into the larger Vermont culture did not feel valued: "I was a country dyke. I didn't have any particular credentials for what was useful to the women's movement. I could milk a cow. What good was that? There was a lot of pressure to be identical and think identically, but I think the truth is we weren't." And of course those of us with children had to struggle to fit into this mobile gang of adventure-seekers. "I had no sense of community. I was a single mom. I was alone. I was isolated with my children."

Don't get me wrong. The Burlington Women's Community was a miracle for many women whose voices and spirits were stifled by the patriarchy for generations. We were often extraordinarily kind to each other. We were strong, gentle, brave, and encouraging.

I doubt whether most of the group dynamics I've pointed out could have been avoided, given our stage of evolution 25 years ago. But, somehow, giving voice to our pain has been healing for me, personally. It's the first step towards forgiveness, and it has helped me to put in perspective

behaviors I no longer value. Despite some considerable embarrassment tinged with shame (since I was one of those overbearing loudmouths, for sure), I wouldn't have traded it for the world. Being an integral part of the Burlington Women's Community was one of the most transformative experiences in my life, and for that, I am deeply grateful.
