

DIRECTIONS TO TREE FROG FARM

Take Rt 5 south from Exit 1 off I 91 for 1 mile to the Guilford Country Store.

Turn right onto Guilford Center Road.

Go about 2 miles to Weatherhead Hollow Road

Turn left onto Weatherhead Hollow Road and go about 7 miles to Parker Corners Road.

Turn right onto Packer Corners Road and go about 2 miles to Kopkind Drive.

Turn left onto Kopkind Drive and follow signs for parking.
